TOP STATFOX HANDICAPPING ANGLES

- CLEMSON is 5-2 ATS (71%) in its L7 games vs. good defenses giving up 17 PPG or less.** Clemson should get plenty of opportunities in the revamped ACC to play to this trend. The Tigers have really stepped up their offensive production in recent years and are now able to compete with these previously overwhelming defenses.
**** Potential spots for 2004: 9/25 at FLST, 11/6 at MIA**
- CLEMSON is 8-15 ATS (35%) as a favorite of 10.5 to 21 points since '92.** Clemson hasn't been one of the elite teams nationally so it hasn't played too many large spreads. When it has, the results have not been favorable. For 2004, the Tigers are as talented as they've been in years so they will have an opportunity to reverse this trend.
**** Potential spots for 2004: 10/16 vs UTST, 11/13 at DUKE**
- Since '92, CLEMSON is 20-12 ATS (63%) against top-level teams (Win Pct. > 75%).** Very similar to the opening trend, Clemson has been motivated by taking on the elite teams. In a schedule loaded with seven bowl teams from 2003, the Tigers will need to continue this trend if they hope to be considered in that company at season's end.
**** Potential spots for 2004: 9/25 at FLST, 11/6 at MIA**

STATFOX QUICK TIPS:

CLEMSON is 10-5 ATS (67%) in its L15 games as a road underdog of 7 points or less.
 CLEMSON is 11-4 ATS (73%) in its L15 revenging a loss scoring less than 14 points.
 CLEMSON is 5-1 ATS (83%) in its L6 games against SEC opponents.

TOP STATFOX HANDICAPPING ANGLES

- FLORIDA ST is 10-0 ATS in its L10 off a close conference win by 7 points or less.** The Seminoles have used these close shaves to get motivated for their next opponent. With the revamping of the ACC, it is not unexpected that Florida State will see more close games than it has in past years, starting with the season opener vs rival Miami.
**** Potential spots for 2004: 9/18 vs UAB, 10/2 vs UNC, 11/6 vs DUKE**
- FLORIDA ST is 8-2 ATS (80%) in its L10 games when the line is +3 to -3.** This trend stands as another testament to how good of a job Bobby Bowden has done as Florida State's head coach. The ability to win expected close games can often make the difference in playing for a national title or not. FSU has thrived in those games.
**** Potential spots for 2004: 9/6 at MIA, 10/30 at MD**
- Since '92, FLORIDA ST is 17-5 ATS (77%) after 2 or more consecutive losses ATS.** Another good sign of a well coached team is the ability to bounce back from below standard performances. Back to back ATS losses seems to be the limit on what Bowden will endure for this team. The Seminoles have converted 77% after losing two straight ATS.
**** Potential spots for 2004: 9/25 vs CLEM, 10/16 vs VA**

STATFOX QUICK TIPS:

FLORIDA ST is 49-28 ATS (64%) when playing a team with a winning record since '92.
 FLORIDA ST is 6-11 ATS (35%) in its L17 games in games played on a neutral field.
 Since '92, FLORIDA ST is 16-6 ATS (73%) coming off back to back home games.
