## TOP STATFOX HANDICAPPING ANGLES

**1** **BUFFALO is 6-13 ATS (32%) in its L19 games versus poor offensive teams - averaging <=4.75 YPP.**  
 Since the retirement of Jim Kelly and Thurman Thomas, and the departure of Andre Reed, the Bills have struggled offensively. Last season, they ranked 30th in the NFL in total offense. When they play against another poor offensive unit, they don't really have an edge.  
**\*\* Potential spots for 2004: 10/31 vs ARI, 12/12 vs CLE**

**2** **Since '92, BUFFALO is 29-18 ATS (62%) in non-conference games.**  
 This is an interesting trend considering this franchise is best known for its Super Bowl failures. The reality is the Bills play in a competitive division that rarely experiences a down year. This prepares them well for non-conference play (11-4 vs NFC West - their '04 opponents).  
**\*\* Potential spots for 2004: 10/31 vs ARI, 11/21 vs STL, 12/26 at SF**

**3** **Since '92, BUFFALO is 11-19 ATS (37%) as a road favorite.**  
 There are several reasons Buffalo has struggled as a road chalk. First, the Bills tend to be overrated by the Chris Bermans of the world. Second, they play on the cold turf of Rich Stadium and have had a hard time adjusting to grass and dome games. Third, The AFC East is a well-balanced division.  
**\*\* Potential spots for 2004: 9/19 at OAK, 12/26 at SF**

**4** **BUFFALO is 6-12 ATS (33%) in its L18 games coming off 3 or more consecutive wins ATS.**  
 Buffalo's last winning season was back in 1999. Therefore, it is not surprising that they've had a difficult time sustaining winning streaks. Unless Buffalo improves dramatically on offense in '04, another mediocre season is inevitable and this trend is likely to continue.  
**\*\* Potential spots for 2004: Any game after 3 straight ATS wins**

### STATFOX QUICK TIPS:

BUF is 1-6 ATS (14%) in its L7 games revenging a home loss against opponent.  
 BUF is 11-4 ATS (73%) in its L15 games coming off an extremely close home win by 3 points or less.  
 BUF is 5-9 ATS (36%) in its L14 games coming off a double digit road win.  
 Since '92, BUF is 21-12 ATS (64%) versus poor defensive teams - allowing >=350 yards/game.
